Transportation Notice**

We do not get buses for the Western Dubuque competition.

Students will be **REQUIRED** to ride with parents to this competition after meeting at Wahlert to help load the trailer and vehicles with equipment and getting checked in.

If for some reason parents cannot attend the competition, students will still need to be riding with a different parent— ***no students are to drive themselves to the competition under any circumstances.***

With the crowd we bring, students driving themselves becomes a parking issue, as well as making for other logistic, legal, and safety concerns.

All students should check in at WCHS still to get their bags checked and help load equipment and then we will caravan to WD.

With this competition, it is really easy to want to take students out, or have them go home in the middle of the day. Please know that I would like all students to remain at the competition during the duration of the competition, just as I would for any other competition. I really appreciate your help and support in enforcing this policy.

Students who do not ride with a parent or leave without permission from me will be subject to not performing in the following competition.

This keeps everyone accountable to the same set of standards. Let me know if there are any questions or concerns about this.

If you live closer to WD, I am fine with you and your students skipping the WCHS check-in and driving straight to WD, but I would like your students to give me a heads up so I know who will not be at check-in.
